SUBMISSION OF CAMP REPORTS

1. Late submission of reports by camps and departments continues to be a problem at the National Organization level. Fortunately, the Department of Kansas has a valid reputation for compliance with the National requirements. As noted in National Commander-in-Chief Charles E. Kuhn, Jr.'s, report to the 127th National Encampment, the Department of Kansas was one of only four departments who submitted their annual reports on time for each of the last five years. This is something about which we can all be proud, because it takes a team effort to make it happen.
2. With the above being said, it is important that we continue to ensure all reports are submitted by camps to the Department, and by the Department to National, on a timely basis. The following due dates are established by National Regulations or Department of Kansas Bylaws:
 - a. **Certificate of Election and Installation of Camp Officers (Form 22).** This form is to arrive at the Department Secretary no later than fifteen (15) days after the installation of officers at the camp. Normally, this form will be completed immediately after the installation, and it should be taken by the installing officer. Remember that a complete roster of camp brothers must accompany the Form 22.
 - b. **Camp Annual Report (Form 27).** This report should be completed as soon as possible after March 31, 2009. It is required to arrive at the Department Secretary no later than three (3) days prior to the Department Encampment, which will be April 22, 2009. An updated copy of the camp roster must also accompany this report.
3. I am sure all camps will meet these requirements. Any camp who fails to hold elections on time or fails to submit a report on time must be suspended. If you have any questions or need any assistance, please let me or the Department Secretary know.
